



## Conflict Between two Extremes

### King Carol II and Nicolae Dumitrescu

Nicolae Dumitrescu was born in 12 October 1912, in Romania in the village Oarja, district Arges, in a family of 13 children from two mothers because the first passed away. The father, Radu Dumitrescu became a wealthy man and was respected and an advisor to those villagers with problems.

Nicu had an inventive inclination. The teachers came to his father, to convince him that Nicolae was far too smart not to let him go to higher education. Nicu went to High School Bratianu, in Pitesti. Although young Nicu became an advisor for young and old and even thought an illiterate servant to read and write.

He entered the faculty of industrial chemistry where he met my sister Agripina. Later they married. During the same period an offer came from the Ministry of Defense with a substantial financial incentive for 5 positions to train for The Pyrotechnical Institute of Bucharest. Nicu came first from 150 students.

As he finished his studies with Magna Cum Laude, The Ministry of Aviation requested the best student to be sent in USA for specialization. Lieutenant Nicu Dumitrescu was strongly recommended. After a lot of waiting an invitation came from Rockefeller Foundation, accepting him and his family.

After an interview with General Uica, Nicu returned home and just said: "We are not going" and never said another word.

After some 50 years I found out that Rockefeller was a wealthy secret association foundation and understood that the condition for Nicu to go for specialization in US was to join the foundation. General Uica took his place and



went to New York with nothing to do except gawking at the International Fair of 1939.

Working in the laboratories of Astra Romana and Pipera on 4 June 1936 Nicu received diploma of Diplomat Engineer by making improvements on aviation gasoline an underground aviation hangar and some other projects.

One night Agripina had a horrible nightmare, she saw him hanging from the street car wires where the line # 1 turn around at the end of the line. That was exactly 7 years before it happened. Then in 1932 New Year Eve they used an old custom to look in the future, they melted some lead and poured it in water, it came out in the shape of a headless man with a child on his left arm and shiny wings like an angel.

I as a child I saw and heard all this but didn't understand too much at that time. Nicu had an extraordinary will power, working till 4-5 AM, sleeping an hour or two and then back to work. A very humble and religious man he was fasting every Friday as a truly puritanical man.

Now an outlook at the proper historical events in Nicu's time.

In 1925 King Carol II was forced by his father King Ferdinand to abdicate, go in exile to Paris, and renounces his rights to the throne as unfit to be a king but brought back by some political machineries. He broke the agreement to renounce the throne. He became a ruthless dictator, one of the wealthiest men on the globe. Beside his permanent lover Madame Lupescu formerly Wolf which was compared with Madame de Pompadour he had daily parties with young beautiful women collected by Bucharest detectives on his orders.

On 25 August 1932 an article appeared on front page in The Globe, Toronto by Pierre van Passen: "Carol's Overthrow Grows Ever Nearer in Stormy Rumania". Discontent in aristocracy extends to all classes and some high ranking officers told the king to get rid of Madam Wolf or they will do it for him. She disappeared but never very far.

On 6 September 1940 he was again forced to abdicate in favor of his son Mihai, but was allowed by General Antonescu to leave with a train of nine cars loaded with his baggage. His departure was moved a few hours earlier thus escaping with his life passing a plot to blow up the train.

In the sixties I read in a newspaper article that he was forbidden to leave Spain and he escaped on the floor of a car with the police in hot pursuit.

Madam Lupescu dream was to become queen, so in 1947 she faked a terminal disease and Carol married her, naming her Princess Elena Carol. She died in 1977. Carol died in 4 April 1953 and his stolen billions of dollars have disappeared. Qoheleth says "Vanity of vanities. For all is vanity" (E-cc. 1 :2)

Coming back to Lieutenant Dumitrescu, in 1939 we find him working for some time with explosives and new flame throwers with a range of about 100 yards as published in The Times (London), 27 January 1939, The New York Times, 26 January 1939, Paris Soir, Le Figaro, and Le Temps 27 January 1939. Encyclopedia Britannica gives the range of flame throwers as 45 yards only.

On January 7 1939 there was an explosion in the conspirator's laboratory at 23 Captain Oarca Street, Bucharest, in the care of an untrained man. All the
